ENTRIES = ++PTF (SO10882)</p> <p>MISSING SARBCH INTERNAL SECURITY CALLS</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION:</p> <p>When using SARBCH utility with /BPRINT, /CHANGE, /DELETE, /EPRINT, /INDEX, /LOAD, /PERM, /PRINT, /PRINTIDX, or /PRINTJOB control statements, users are able to perform the respective actions even though they should not be allowed to access the report. This happens when CA-View security is set to internal.</p> <p>After applying this solution the users will be able to perform the actions listed above only for the reports to which they have access. Below is the information about each mode.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If the user has access to ALL mode, user is allowed to access all the reports generated by CA-View and CA-Deliver. 2. If user has access to SARO mode, user is allowed to access all the reports that are generated by CA-View. 3. If user has access to JOB mode, user is allowed to access all the jobs that are collected by CA-View, if the JOB record for the job is created. 4. If the user has access to EXPO mode, user is allowed to access all the reports generated by CA-Deliver. <p>For modes SAR and EXP, access to the reports for the actions listed above is granted based on the following criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Distribution-id should be defined for the user. 2. Report has to be defined to the distribution-id of the user. 3. REPRT field for the report that is defined to distribution-id should be set to Y for the report for all the control statements listed above except for /DELETE control statement. If REPRT field is set to N, then the users will not be able to perform the action for the control statements. <p>For /DELETE control statement, criteria is the DEL field for the report that is defined to distribution-id. If DEL field is set to Y for the report, then the user will be able to delete the report. If DEL field is set to N, then the user will not be able to delete the report.</p> <p>SYMPTOMS:</p> <p>When using the control statements listed above while also using internal security, SARBCH ends successfully and performs the requested action, even though users don't have access to report.</p> <p>IMPACT:</p> <p>When using internal security, users are able to view reports, and to perform the actions listed above on the reports that they should not be allowed to access.</p> <p>CIRCUMVENTION:</p> <p>Switch to external security.</p> <p>PRODUCT(S) AFFECTED:</p> <table border="0"> <tr> <td>CA-View</td> <td>Version 12.2</td> </tr> <tr> <td>CA-View</td> <td>Version 14.0</td> </tr> </table> <p>Related Problem:</p> <p>VIEW 2097</p> <p>Copyright (C) 2019 CA. ENTRIES = ++PTF (SO11025)</p> <p>MTC-CV: DATABASE ERRORS AFTER SO10219, SO10240 OR SO10327</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION: After applying PTF SO10219, SO10240 or SO10327, database connections are not always closed properly resulting in various database errors.</p> <p>SYMPTOMS: One or more of the following symptoms may occur:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Out of memory conditions in either the CCS Tomcat or the H2 server regions. - The database file growing to a large size on disk. The database file is the <database-name> specified on the DBLOCATION parameter. - The DRAS_Repository_Import utility and the Export_Rule_Import utility fail with exception UnsupportedOperationException and text "Unsupported database: h2". - The following message repeated many times in the CCS Tomcat log: "CAHVS0200I Database H2 driver org.h2.Driver loaded" <p>IMPACT: - The CCS Tomcat or the H2 server region may abnormally terminate due to an out of memory condition. - The file system where the database file resides may become full if the database file grows large enough. - The DRAS_Repository_Import utility and the Export_Rule_Import utility cannot be used.</p> <p>CIRCUMVENTION: Remove PTFs SO10219, SO10240 and SO10327.</p> <p>PRODUCT(S) AFFECTED: CA Output Management Web Viewer Version 14.0</p> <p>Related Problem: DVWEB 635</p> <p>Copyright (C) 2019 CA. Such invalid records are normally ignored, but RMOGRW utility can still interpret those records as valid, providing the user with incorrect information.</p> <p>SYMPTOMS: When you use RMOGRW to print the information for the report for which the residual records exist, you will receive some information for it. However, if you try to access that report through ONLINE interface, report is not found.</p> <p>IMPACT: RMOGRW returns invalid information for deleted report with residual records existing in the database.</p> <p>CIRCUMVENTION: None.</p> <p>PRODUCT(S) AFFECTED: CA-Deliver Release 12.2 CA-Deliver Release 14.0</p> <p>Related Problem: DLVR 834</p> <p>Copyright (C) 2019 CA.
