TAMRSMF sample JCL for getting SMF reports on resource access due to TAMR ELEVATES was improperly titled in its doc box.</li> </ol> <p>SYMPTOMS:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. TAMRSAMP sample JCL has RACF commands without clear indications to which fields need to be filled in by the user. Running the job as-is will likely result in failures as the ID's and permitted resources may not exist to the RACF database.</li> <li>2. Job will run without issue. Title change is just in comment box.</li> </ol> <p>IMPACT:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. TAMRSAMP job will likely fail. Security setup for TAMR users will need to be performed manually.</li> <li>2. None to product functionality. Title change is in a comment box.</li> </ol> <p>CIRCUMVENTION:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Administrators will likely need to manually issue the commands to permit existing users to the resources as they are defined in their environment instead of using the TAMRSAMP job directly.</li> <li>2.
