IMPACT: The transferred data is incorrect on the receiving side, and is unsuitable for processing. CIRCUMVENTION: Reformat the input dataset to not contain spanned records, if possible. SYMPTOMS: XCOM abends with code S047 and the XCOMJOB or XCOMXFER address space is terminated. IMPACT: This abend terminates the XCOM address space. CIRCUMVENTION: Ensure that XCOMJOB, XCOMJOBI, and XCOMXFER are all appropriately APF authorized. CIRCUMVENTION: Manually enable any DEST members which were not properly enabled during server startup.
