The DBDSMPR abend can occur when maintaining a table in an area which uses Data Space Reclamation Option (DSOP) 3, which is "clustering". Clustering is not a commonly used space reclamation option. The problem is due to an internal coding error that failed to insert the correct table name in the request area. SYMPTOMS: Adding a key to an existing table via the APPLYCXX feature can receive OPEN error message: DB00501E - OPEN ERROR - RETURN CODE 02 (052) CXX=cxxname (nnnnn) ***DBKEY where nnnnn denotes the DBID and the invalid table name is shown as blanks before the DBID. A PXX dump is produced. The key is added to the CXX, but population of the index is delayed until the next OPEN of a URT against the related table. The error is based on an invalid XCF message received by the surviving member. This solution will ignore the invalid message and thus eliminate the error code and ensuing PXX dump.
