When we get called for validation of these packages, no authchk id is being passed and we either give an SOC3 abend or CADB2038 message with a dump based upon what level of code is running for module CADB2SEC. The code has been changed that if we do not get an authchk id passed for an execute of a package, we will then use the current sqlid instead.
