ENTRIES = ++PTF (S014733) WEB VIEWER: ADMIN CHECKS FOR REPOSITORY LIST AND REPORT LIST PROBLEM DESCRIPTION: Web Viewer issues a security call for class CHA1VIEW resource WEBVWR.ADMIN to determine if the user is a regular user or an administrator. If the user does not have read access to CHA1VIEW WEBVWR.ADMIN, the security call fails and the user is considered a regular user. The failed security call also results in a security violation message in the application logs. Web Viewer issues the CHA1VIEW WEBVWR.ADMIN security call for: - Login to determine if the administrator menu should be displayed. - The export action to determine the user's access to export rules. - Managing repositories requires administrator authority. - Managing repository groups requires administrator authority. Web Viewer is incorrectly issuing the CHA1VIEW WEBVWR.ADMIN security call every time a regular user requests a repository list or report list. The additional security calls generate excess security violation messages for regular users. SYMPTOMS: Regular users receive a security violation message (ACF04056, TSS7250E or ICH408I) in the application logs every time a repository list or report list is requested. IMPACT: The security violation message confirms the user is a regular user, it does not affect product functionality. CIRCUMVENTION: Ignore the security violation message or make the user an administrator to prevent the message. Note: If specified when you are in ALL Mode, it will save the specification for ALL Mode. If specified when you are in EXP or EXPO Mode, it will save the specification for both EXP and EXPO Modes. If specified when you are in JOB Mode, it will save the specification for JOB Mode. If specified when you are in SAR or SARO Mode, it will save the specification for both SAR and SARO Modes.
