ENTRIES = ++PTF (SO14432)</p> <p>UPDATE COMMAND WITH LARGE SYSIN UNABLE TO UPDATE FILES</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION:</p> <p>A batch execution processing a large SYSIN that contains multiple UPDATE commands fails to update files.</p> <p>SYMPTOMS:</p> <p>An UPDATE command executed successfully but the number of updates shows 0 in the statistics for a file that actually meets the selection criteria for the UPDATE command.</p> <p>IMPACT:</p> <p>An incorrect result is obtained. If the user does not inspect the report the error might go unnoticed.</p> <p>CIRCUMVENTION:</p> <p>Break the SYSIN into several pieces and run several jobs.</p> <p>PRODUCT(S) AFFECTED:</p> <table> <tr> <td>CA File Master Plus common component</td><td>Version 11.0</td></tr> <tr> <td>CA File Master Plus common component</td><td>Version 12.0</td></tr> </table> <p>Related Problem:</p> <p>FMMVS 1449</p> <p>Copyright (C) 2020 CA.
