It always creates an SSM Version 2 table, regardless of the setting of the SSMVERSION parameter. SYMPTOMS: AOF rules, OPS/REXX programs and OPSVIEW itself will get an error if they attempt to reference SSM Version 3 columns in an SSM Version 2 resource table that was created using OPSSMTBL. IMPACT: When running with parameter SSMVERSION set to 3, the LOAD command of the OPSVIEW option 4.11.P.R - SSM Resource Policy Manager fails when attempting to load SSM resource definitions into an SSM resource table that was created by OPSSMTBL.
