ENTRIES = ++PTF (LU00088)</p> <p>ISPF ERROR WHEN EXITING THE DSN LIST DIALOG</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION:</p> <p>When a user selects the "D" option (DSN LIST) from the main menu in a File Master for IMS session to finally require an ISPF Browse or ISPF Edit for one of the datasets or library member from the DSN List, then an ISPF session is started from within File Master for IMS.</p> <p>When the user terminates the ISPF session to return back to the DSN List dialog, ISPF error messages are displayed and the File Master for IMS session is terminated.</p> <p>SYMPTOMS:</p> <p>After exiting the ISPF editor session (Browse or Edit), the following error messages are displayed and the File Master for IMS session is terminated. Control is given back to ISPF.</p> <p>*** DISPLAY OF 'CAWKPDLF' RECEIVED A RETURN CODE OF 12</p> <p>*** Panel 'CAWKPDLF' error</p> <p>*** Panel not found.</p> <p>*** DISPLAY OF 'CAWKPDLS' RECEIVED A RETURN CODE OF 12</p> <p>*** Panel 'CAWKPDLS' error</p> <p>*** Panel not found.</p> <p>IMPACT:</p> <p>The current File Master for IMS session terminates and control is given back to ISPF.</p> <p>CIRCUMVENTION:</p> <p>There is no circumvention possible.</p> <p>Once the problem occurs, the File Master for IMS session terminates.
