Files that have not been touched for years, maybe not on the MVS/Catalog, maybe under special expiration date control. These EARL reports will also (optionally) generate control statements based on the type of records being reported, to allow for easier processing. SYMPTOMS: Files may be "lost" because they had an expiration date far into the future, were created under CYCLE/xxx control or CATALOG control and are no longer being created or a number of other reasons. These sample EARL reports will make it easier to identify and clean up. IMPACT: With Virtual Tape Solutions, it is often easy to overlook lost or obsolete tape files. These new EARL reports make it easier to find these lost files and expire them. Remember to always analyze the output reports before actually taking action such as running TMSUPDTE to expire tape volumes. SYMPTOMS: Tape datasets then cannot be used for OPEN/INPUT processing as the DSN in the catalog does not match the DSN in the TMC, and the tape is rejected with IEFTMS50 1XX-08 Abends. IMPACT: Tape data set names no longer match in the MVS catalog and the TMC. When the tapes are attempted to be used in OPEN/INPUT processing, the tapes are rejected. CIRCUMVENTION: N/A.
