It does perform the function of printing the indicated detail displays, but leaves the PRINT file open and provides no visual indication of what it did. SYMPTOMS: The SP line command just redisplay the data on UFILESYS, ULISTDIR, UPROCESS with no message, and doesn't close the generated PRINT file. IMPACT: Confusion on whether the SP line command worked. CIRCUMVENTION: After using SP line command issue PRINT CLOSE.
