ENTRIES = ++PTF (LU03299) CA7 HANG DURING AUTO REQUEUE AFTER IPL PROBLEM DESCRIPTION: A timing condition may cause CA 7 to hang when AUTO REQUEUEing active jobs that were executing on a CPU that was IPLed. This condition only occurs when an active job has VRM resources attached. SYMPTOMS: Jobs stop being tracked and submitted and CA7 becomes unresponsive. IMPACT: Most CA7ONL activity stops. Some CA 7 commands may be able to execute successfully. CIRCUMVENTION: Cancel and restart CA 7. ENTRIES = ++PTF (LU03541) DATASET TRIGGER ERRONEOUSLY DELETED PROBLEM DESCRIPTION: When a dataset that does not trigger jobs is deleted, it is possible that job trigger definitions for another dataset may be deleted. SYMPTOMS: After a non-triggering dataset is deleted, jobs that should have been triggered by another dataset are not triggered, and the trigger definitions are no longer present in the database. IMPACT: Jobs that should have been triggered are not triggered. CIRCUMVENTION: It may be possible to circumvent the problem by issuing a 'clearing' command immediately prior to deleting a non-triggering dataset. The clearing command is: LCTLG,DSN=ABC.D* Note the clearing command must be entered on the same terminal as the dataset delete.
