PROBLEM DESCRIPTION: When a user tries to update the profiles for an ACID, the profiles may not get updated properly. SYMPTOMS: The user will get an error when updating the profiles for an ACID. He may see TSS0353E USER ALREADY ATTACHED TO PROFILE/GROUP. IMPACT: The profiles may be entirely wrong since the code stops updating once the error is hit. CIRCUMVENTION: They could try to just add any new profiles individually and not try to do any replaces. SYMPTOMS: Users still have OMVS Program and OMVS home directories specified in thier TSS ACID IMPACT: LDAP Identity Manager users are unable to remove the above attributes. IMPACT: The value returned is wrong and does not match the dn name for the objectclass.
