After applying 19.0 PTF LU00620 (ADS zIIP Enablement), a zIIP enabled CV can experience various issues such as a SOC1, SOC4, hanging or looping after an ADS task abends. Note: The PEA mentioned in this title is for this first issue. 2.) A zIIP enabled CV can abend with a 3909 when attempting to write the message DC016100. This FIX will include a modified DC016100 message when a MEMLIMIT is exceeded. 3.) A CV attempting to acquire a secondary allocation of 64 bit scratch storage when processing a PUT SCRATCH may encounter a program check in RHDCSCRM +C62. SYMPTOMS: 1.) After an ADS task abends with the zIIP enabled, the CV can experience a hang or a loop without an error message from the abending ADS task. The CV can also come down with a SOC1 or a SOC4 abend. 2.) When a ZIIP enabled CV encounters a failed 64-bit storage request, IDMS attempts to write the message DC016100 and the CV can abend with a 3909. The new fix will include a modified message DC016100 message when the MEMLIMIT was exceeded or when MEMLIMIT=0. 3.) The customer can experience a DC027002 Vnnn Tnn SYSTEM MODULE PROGRAM CHECKED NEAR RHDCSCRM AT OFFSET C62 when the CV attempts to allocate a secondary 64 bit scratch storage from a PUT SCRATCH. IMPACT: 1.) If the zIIP enabled CV hangs or loops it must be cancelled and restarted, or the CV abends with a SOC1 or a SOC4 and has to be restarted. 2.) The zIIP enabled CV will come down with a user completion abend code 3909 and has to be restarted. 3.) The application PUT SCRATCH will fail. CIRCUMVENTION: 1.) Disable zIIP processing by specifying as a CV Startup paramater zIIP=N or issue the DCMT VARY ZIIP OFF command after the zIIP enabled CV is up and before executing any ADS tasks. Or the LU00620 can be backed out. 2.) Disable zIIP processing by specifying as a CV Startup Paramter zIIP=N. 3.) Increase your primary scratch storage to avoid allocating secondary storage 64 bit storage or change the SCRATCH LOCATION to XA to only obtain storage from XA Storage instead of 64 bit storage.
