ENTRIES = ++PTF (LU04680) CA 7 REST API AUTHORIZATION SERVICES ENHANCEMENT DESCRIPTION: This enhancement will allow mainframe security administrators to control access to CA 7 REST API query services using external security (ACF2, RACF, Top Secret) rules similar to what is used by CA 7 itself. In addition, the /DISPLAY,T= command has been updated to provide more granularity. The TYPE column will now display TCPIP for terminals accessing CA 7 using the TCPIP terminal interface and REST for CA 7 REST API service access. Sites currently running Release 12.1.02 of the CA 7 REST API must implement Release 12.1.03 of the CA 7 REST API at the time they install this PTF. Sites need to perform the HOLD ACTION instructions in this PTF before implementing Release 12.1.03 of the CA 7 REST API. Failure to do so will impact the CA 7 REST API query services used for Administration and also those used by the CA 7 Datacom Server. Sites will need to APPLY this PTF even if not using, or planning on using, the CA 7 REST API since existing CA 7 modules required changes to support the new features. The HOLD ACTION can be bypassed. ENTRIES = ++PTF (LU04682) JOB SUBMISSION STOPS AFTER DATACOM FAILURE (SUBSEL=ENH ONLY) PROBLEM DESCRIPTION: After a Datacom failure in the CA7ONL address space, one of the following situations may potentially occur. Both situations are timing dependent and may not occur even if Datacom fails. The Datacom failure is likely related to a cancel of the Datacom MUF. 1) If using the SUBSEL=ENH option on the OPTIONS statement of the INIT deck, job submission may stop. 2) If not using the SUBSEL=ENH option, a job may be in a different state in the queues after a CA 7 restart than it was before the restart. SYMPTOMS: Prior to one of the two scenarios described above, the following message will be displayed in the CA 7 JES log: CAL2D137E L2DBTASK abnormally terminated After the message, a dump with title of 'CAMASTER . . . DBPCCPR' or 'CA 7 L2DBTASK ABEND' will likely be generated. IMPACT: 1) If using the SUBSEL=ENH option, job submission stops. Contact CA 7 support for assistance in correcting the database so that submission will restart. 2) If not using the SUBSEL=ENH option, use CA 7 commands to take appropriate action against the job that is found to be in the incorrect state. CIRCUMVENTION: Do not cancel the Datacom MUF while CA 7 is up. It is best practice to shut CA 7 down before issuing EOJ to the MUF.
