As part of this fix, the version of ZLIB that is used with zEDC is being updated to 1.2.11. SYMPTOMS: High CPU usage for transfers using zEDC hardware compression. IMPACT: Any performance benefits of using zEDC for compression are lost due to increased CPU use. CIRCUMVENTION: If zEDC is present on the processor hardware, use a compression algorithm other than ZLIB, or use no compression at all. ENTRIES = ++PTF (LU05272) MISALIGNED TSS/RACF/ACF2 MESSAGES USING MSGFMT=STANDARD PROBLEM DESCRIPTION: When the XCOM server is configured with MSGFMT=STANDARD, messages that are returned from the security product (TSS/RACF/ACF2) are incorrectly split in the versions that are written to the SYSLOG via WTO. SYMPTOMS: MSGFMT=STANDARD places the message identifier at the beginning of the message. The message identifiers from TSS/RACF/ACF2 are shorter than the 10 characters that XCOM uses. This causes a problem when parsing the shorter message IDs to move them for the alternate WTO format. The first character of the message text is moved with the identifier, and consequently, it is not placed properly with the actual text of the message itself. IMPACT: This is a cosmetic problem. CIRCUMVENTION: To avoid this problem, change XCOM's "MSGFMT=" parameter setting to "XCOM".
