We attempt to find this information first by checking the incore directory (PDSN) to see if the data is there. If found, the info is passed back to the caller. If not found, we issue an I/O request to the database for each call to see if we can find the record in the database that contains that info. We should not be trying to read the records from the database if we do not find the information in a directory. SYMPTOMS: Excessive I/O requests to the database trying to retrieve the RESOWNER and DATAKEY on an SMS dataset allocation. IMPACT: Possible contention against the ACF2 info-stg database CIRCUMVENTION: If there are records that should be included in the PDSN directory issue the 'F ACF2,REBUILD(DSN),CLASS(P)' command. Otherwise there is no circumvention. Example resource rule: \$KEY(RESTRICT) TYPE(AUT) CHECK.SURROGAT UID(uid_of_execution_lid) ALLOW - uid_of_execution_lid is the UID string of the execution logonid that has the RESTRICT attribute. ACF2 will still check the RESTRICT Logonid's PROGRAM and SUBAUTH, if present, to make sure they are valid.
