ENTRIES = ++PTF (LU02447)</p> <p>MODULE NOT FOUND IN PMO HASH TABLE AFTER PDS COMPRESS</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION:</p> <p>Module not found or other I/O errors accessing modules following a library compress operation.</p> <p>PMO was not issuing any ENQs or RESERVEs when processing PDS directories. This introduces a timing exposure that can occur when a PDS is being compressed at the same time PMO is reading the directory to build a hash table.</p> <p>This problem was originally reported on an IMS RESLIB data set after compression by CA-Disk. The hash table built by PMO was empty if PMO happened to read the directory after CA-Disk had copied the library to make a backup and then cleared the directory before copying data back.</p> <p>PMO is modified to issue a shared ENQ/RESERVE for SPFEDIT and SYSIEWLP resources while reading a PDS directory.
