Improper value of res_tstate is returned from SSMSTAUX to SSMSTATE so that the state of CA-CCS CAS9/RIM component is not set correctly. IMPACT: SSM may not properly reflect the correct current state for resources checked in SSMSTATE and SSMSTAUX. CIRCUMVENTION: None.
