SYMPTOMS: Users might find culturally insensitive terminology in the MIM documentation set, commands, messages, health checks, and SMF reports. This refers to the use of the terms "master" and "client" to describe the relationship between systems that control and request the Virtual Control File (VCF). These terms are replaced with "controller" and "requester". IMPACT: Potentially offending our valued customers and portraying Broadcom in a negative light. CIRCUMVENTION: None. ENTRIES = ++PTF (LU08510) REWORK(2023039) MIGRATION TO DIFFERENT MASTER AFTER SYSTEM REMOVAL PROBLEM DESCRIPTION: This PTF addresses 2 problems: <1> CA MIM may migrate to a different VCF master system if the following occur: - CA MIM is using a Virtual Control File. - COMMUNICATION=CTCDASD. - A VCF requester is IPLd without shutting down MIM. - The VCF requester had a reserve on the control file - SET MIM DOWNSYS=AUTOFREE causes the VCF master system to enter VCF RECOVERY processing to clear the reserve from the VCF requester. <2> If COMMUNICATION=XCF and there are systems in the MIMPLEX which are not all in the same Sysplex, the DOWNSYS=AUTOFREE feature may automatically free a system that was removed from the Sysplex. SYMPTOMS: <1> VCF RECOVERY completes normally, but the VCF is now on a different system. <2> MIM0061W or MIM0350W messages may be issued for the system that was removed from the sysplex. IMPACT: <1> ENQ performance may degrade if the new master system is not desired. <2> If a system is not automatically freed, then resources held by the removed system may not be available. CIRCUMVENTION: <1> The MIGRATE VCF command can be used to move the VCF back to the desired master system. <2> The FREE command can be used to free a system from the MIMPLEX.
