PROBLEM DESCRIPTION: When map is upgraded to V10, the DSNList table is removed from the Map database. Older versions of the code won't run without it. Older versions of DSN lists may have an empty list. This causes the conversion of DSNs to Group lists to fail. SYMPTOMS: If you run older MAP code on a V10 MAPDB, tomcat will not start. When trying to convert a MAPDB databases DSN list to group lists, it will fail with a -18 error. IMPACT: CEM will not run with the old MAP code. Users cannot convert DSN lists to group lists. CIRCUMVENTION: Get on the latest MAP code to allow Tomcat ot start up. Manually delete the bad DSNList that has no DSN associated with it.
