## CA Mainframe Software Manager

The following functionality has been added for CA MSM Version 04.0.00:

- Software Deployment Service (SDS)—Use this service to deploy CA Technologies mainframe products to your target enterprise systems.
- Database Migration Tool—Use this tool to migrate your current CA MSM database after you upgrade CA MSM.
- Automatic Download Scheduling—Use this tool to automatically obtain updates for products and product releases on a regular basis.

## CA MSM Serviceability

This release of your security product includes enhancements to support CA MSM serviceability, which is part Mainframe 2.0 common services. Serviceability helps users identify, manage, and respond to a failing program.

Serviceability enables the following:

- Ensures that error messages provide clear information for use in problem determination.
- Identifies ownership of resources.
- Ensures module and storage protection.
- Facilitates self-help.
- Simplifies identification of preventative and corrective maintenance.

## Installation Changes

As part of our Mainframe 2.0 initiative, CA mainframe products are moving to a standardized installation and packaging methodology. This methodology simplifies product installation and maintenance and offers additional installation choices.

With CA Auditor r12.1, you can select one of three methods of product installation (base license only):

- CA MSM
- Pax-Enhanced ESD
- Physical tape media

In support of the Mainframe 2.0 strategy, CA Auditor SMP/E packaging has been streamlined and standardized. Specific changes are as follows:

- Product installation jobs have been replaced. As part of CA Mainframe 2.0 deliverables, CA Auditor packaging has been simplified and standardized to conform to CA Mainframe 2.0 packaging and installation standards. Doing so provides a singular look-and-feel for all CA mainframe products. Carefully review the installation instructions provided in the Installation Guide.

Product installation sample jobs have been separated from product configuration and sample usage jobs. The former now reside in the CAI.SAMPJCL data set, and the latter now reside in the CAI.CAJ0JCLx data sets and are also SMP/E-maintained.

- Data set names have changed.
- The FMID naming convention has changed. CA Auditor r12.0 FMIDs followed the CJOC000 format whereas r12.1 FMIDs follows the new CAJ0nnn format. The FMID for CA Auditor r12.1 is CAJOC10.

For more information, see the *Installation Guide* and the Product Maintenance Letter (PML) that accompanies CA Auditor r12.1.

## Data Set Name Changes

The names of all data sets have been changed for CA Auditor r12.1. We recommend that you carefully review the following table and assess any impact these changes have to your installation. Changes can impact z/OS configuration definitions, ISPF configuration/operation procedures, operating procedures, assembly/link-edit customization jobs and procedures, scheduled jobs, and more.

## Documentation

This section contains topics related to documentation enhancements.

### Message Reference Guide

All messages that were previously included in the *Installation Guide* are now located in the new *Message Reference Guide*.

### CA HTML Bookshelf

This release contains the CA HTML bookshelf, which is an HTML help system that provides access to all deliverables in the product documentation set in both HTML and PDF. HTML provides robust online viewing and search capabilities, while PDF provides a print-friendly option.

The HTML bookshelf features include:

- A single help screen that displays all documentation for this release.
- An all-in-one search tool that searches the entire documentation set and returns matches found in both the HTML and PDF formatted documentation, without the need for a specialized .PDX index file.
- Additional links for using the bookshelf, downloading Acrobat Reader, and contacting CA Technologies.

**Note:** You must have Adobe Reader 8 or above to view the PDF files in the bookshelf.

## Search the Bookshelf

The bookshelf includes a search facility that helps you locate information throughout the set.

### To search the bookshelf

1. Enter your search criteria in the Search field in the upper right corner of the bookshelf and press Enter.

The search returns HTML results listed by topic and PDF results listed by guide. The results are sorted by date so that the most recently updated topics or PDFs appear at the top of the list. To find a topic in a PDF, open the PDF and view the list of topics within the PDF that match the search criteria.

2. (Optional) Click Sort by Relevance.

The list is reordered so that the HTML topics or PDFs that contain the most matches appear at the top of the list.
