# Chapter 2: New Features and Enhancements

---

CA Chorus for Security and Compliance Management Version 04.0.00 includes the following new features and enhancements.

## **CA Chorus Bookshelves are Split for Version 4.0**

Individual bookshelves are now available for CA Chorus and the CA Chorus disciplines. Note that each discipline bookshelf includes a Release Notes and Administration Guide specific for that discipline. The Installation Guide and Message Reference Guide are included in the CA Chorus platform bookshelf and include platform and discipline topics.

The CA Chorus 4.0 bookshelf has been split into 5 separate bookshelves:

- There are now individual bookshelves for each discipline and the platform.
- *Release Notes* and *Administrator Guide* exists for each discipline.
- The *Installation Guide* and *Message Reference Guide* continue to include platform and discipline topics.

## **Change Password**

Security administrators can reset a user password from the Investigator Launcher pane. This makes it possible to review password violations and reset passwords from the same UI pane.

### IBM RACF Support

CA Chorus for Security and Compliance Management 4.0 provides support for IBM RACF. You now have the ability to collect IBM RACF users, groups/roles, and permissions in the CIA database and view the data in the CA Chorus Investigator. The collected data helps system programmers and security administrators understand the state of their security environment and identify what actions to take, saving time and cost in administrating security and meeting compliance objectives. Unlike CA ACF2 and CA Top Secret users, IBM RACF users cannot edit object details. The edit icon in the Details pane of the Investigator and Investigation Launcher remains disabled for IBM RACF users.

### Unified Install Process

The unified install process unloads and configures the CA Chorus security discipline software prerequisites as a single set, simplifying and expediting the install process. The unified method supports CA Datacom on a single system. If you wish to install on multiple systems or want to use DB2 as your database, you must use the manual method.

We recommend that you perform the following steps in sequence::

- Download and apply all required CA Security Product Maintenance (Section 2.2)
- Download Unified Install Pax file (1407.pax.Z) and perform steps to create the product libraries and CSI. The steps are documented in the Unified Install Process chapter of the CA Chorus™ for Security and Compliance Management Site Preparation Guide. Perform the steps up to the running of the STAG\*\*\*\* job.
- Download and apply any maintenance that is available on the beta site for the unified install. Maintenance can be applied using CSM if the unified install was imported into CSM. If it was not imported, there are jobs on the FTP site that can be used to receive and apply any maintenance.
- Download the Security and Compliance Discipline Pax file (E1M40B0.pax.Z) from the FTP site. Install this Pax file using CSM selecting SEC/CO. Do not do any configuration at this time.
- Install the Chorus 4.0 Platform using CSM. Do not do any configuration at this time.
- Download and apply any maintenance that is available for the CA Chorus Security and Compliance Discipline.
- Download and apply any maintenance that is available for the CA Chorus Platform.
- Continue with the steps to install and configure the unified install using the appropriate STAG\*\*\*\* job for your site. These steps are documented in the Unified Install Process chapter of the CA Chorus™ for Security and Compliance Management Site Preparation Guide.

- Complete the configuration of the CA Chorus Security and Compliance Discipline and the CA Chorus Platform using the documentation in the CA Chorus Site Preparation Guide.
