Chapter 1: Welcome to PMO Accelerator

Welcome to the CA Clarity PMO Accelerator v3.0 add-in (PMO Accelerator) release notes. This add-in is based on CA Clarity Project & Portfolio Manager (CA Clarity PPM) v13.0.00. This document can help you get started with this add-in.

What's New in v3.0

The following new features and enhancements are available with this version:

- Consistent look-and-feel for portlets throughout CA Clarity PPM. Field names and column layouts are consistent across portlets. The following are some examples:
 - EAC cost is calculated using the same rules on all portlets as on project management pages.
 - The Properties icon is the first column on several portlets and list views. The icon links you to the properties page of the object (for example, project or resource).
 - The Settings subpage is consistently defined across projects, programs, non-project investments, resources, and portfolios allowing segregation of access through sub-page level security.
- View protection when installing the new version of PMO. See View Protection (see page 11) for details.
- Visibility to the following key project indicators:
 - Schedule and Schedule%
 - Days Late and Days Late%
 - Projected Cost Variance and Projected Cost Variance %
 - Projected Effort Variance and Projected Effort Variance %
- Portlet queries updated to support latest ANSI standards, better performance, and support for the same cost calculations as available in CA Clarity PPM.
- New and enhanced Portlets. See New and Improved Portlets (see page 9) for a list of these portlets.
- New attributes such as Schedule% and Days Late% included on all portlets that have the Schedule and Days Late indicators.
- Several enhancements to projects as follows:
 - Projected Cost and Effort Variance indicators are available.
 - New Actions menu options are available that provide the following:
 - Visibility to all timesheets associated to a project from the Project Team
 - Visibility to all posted financial transactions from the Project Financial Plans tab.
- Project Manager Schedule Dashboard portlet now includes subprojects.
- Project Manager Cost and Effort Dashboard portlet now includes subprojects in the hierarchical list.
- Earned value cost and effort-related fields are available as configurable for all portlets.

Full localization support in 16 languages.

Chapter 2: Upgrade Information

Review the Add-In Before Applying

Install the PMO Accelerator add-in on your CA Clarity application server so that the content is available to you. See the CA Clarity PPM Installation Guide for information about installing the PMO Accelerator add-in.

Follow these steps:

- 1. Log in to CA Clarity PPM.
- Open Administration, and from Studio, click Add-ins.
 - The Add-Ins page appears.
- Click the Accelerator: Program Management Office add-in (ID: csk). The Add-In Details page appears.
- Review the changes to installed add-in items and new add-in items.

If you have previously configured views, the configurations are preserved and are not overwritten during installation. You can decide which new or updated views to apply. Use the details page of the add-in in Studio to select new or modified items and apply them. Applying a Studio object overwrites the existing configuration of the Studio object views.

For more information about how PMO Accelerator configures views, see the PMO Accelerator Product Guide.

The Studio Add-In Details page lists all of the items that are included with the add-in. The following fields display on the page:

Name

Indicates the add-in name in a hierarchical relationship determined by dependencies among the items.

Status

Indicates if the add-in item is applied or not in CA Clarity PPM.

Values:

- Not Installed. New items that are new to the add-in version or that you did not apply from a previous add-in version.
- Upgrade Ready. Modified items that you applied from a previous add-in version and then configured. An update to the item is included in the current add-in version.

Important! Consider the configurations you have made to items before applying them. Applying modified items overwrites your configurations.

Installed. Items that are installed.

Type

Indicates the item type.

Values: Object, Lookup, Page, Tab, Portlet, Query, Custom View, Menu, Group, Project, Process, Role, and Report/Job

ID

Displays the add-in item code, which is the identifier of the applied add-in item.

Apply the Add-In

Perform the steps described in this section if you have an existing installation of the add-in, or if you have previously configured CA Clarity PPM Studio objects.

Follow these steps:

- 1. Log in to CA Clarity PPM.
- 2. Open Administration, and from Studio, click Add-Ins.

The Add-Ins page appears.

3. Click the Accelerator: Program Management Office add-in (ID: csk).

The Add-In Details page appears.

4. Review the items in the list and select the items that are "Upgrade Ready" or "Not Installed."

Note: By default, when you upgrade to the current add-in version, the items that are new or modified are pre-selected.

5. (Upgrade Only) For all active process instances with the "Upgrade Ready" status, cancel and delete the process instance.

Contact your CA Clarity PPM administrator or see the Administration Guide for more information.

6. Click Apply.

Note: Selected items with dependency on other items are also updated.

A list of updated items displays on the confirmation or install page.

7. Click Yes to update or install the items.

If a user has previously changed an item listed on the confirmation or install page, publish the item before displaying the update to the users.

See the Studio Developer's Guide for more information.

As of PMO Accelerator v2.0, the PMO Accelerator add-in includes portlets, processes, subobjects, and templates that you may already have if the Best Practices Accelerator (BPA) was previously installed. If you are upgrading from PMO Accelerator v1.3, and you have the BPA installed, refer to the Upgrading from Clarity's Best Practices Accelerator to PMO Accelerator v2.1 document for details on how to manage your upgrade to this PMO Accelerator version.
