Chapter 1: New Features

This section describes the features that have been added to CA Copycat Utility r12.

- New Product Name
- CA Mainframe 2.0 Support

New Product Name

CA 1 Copycat and CA TLMS Copycat have been combined into a single product and renamed to *CA Copycat Utility*. A new LMP key is required, and is automatically shipped with the new CA Copycat Utility r12 product.

CA Mainframe 2.0 Support

CA Copycat Utility has been enabled for Mainframe 2.0 product installation and management improvements. Mainframe 2.0 is our strategy for providing leadership in the mainframe operating environment. We intend to lead the mainframe marketplace for customer experience, Out-Tasking solutions, and solution innovation. After listening to customer needs and requirements to keep the mainframe operating environment viable and cost-effective, we are providing new tools to simplify usage and to energize this operating environment for years to come.

CA Mainframe Software Manager (CA MSM) is an important step in realizing the Mainframe 2.0 strategy. CA MSM simplifies and standardizes the delivery, installation, and maintenance of mainframe products on z/OS systems. CA MSM has a browser-based user interface (UI) with a modern look and feel for managing those solutions. As products adopt Mainframe 2.0 features and CA MSM services, you can acquire, install, and manage your software in a common way.

Chapter 2: Enhancements to Existing Features

This chapter describes the enhancements that have been made to previously existing features.

- Common Code Base

CA Mainframe Software Manager

The following functionality has been added for CA MSM r3.0:

- Software Deployment Service (SDS)—Use this service to deploy CA mainframe products to your target enterprise systems.
- Database Migration Tool—Use this tool to migrate your current CA MSM database after you upgrade CA MSM.
- Automatic Download Scheduling—Use this tool to automatically obtain updates for products and product releases on a regular basis.

Common Code Base

To support a single CA Copycat Utility product for both CA 1 and CA TLMS environments, CA Copycat Utility has been enhanced to dynamically determine which tape management system is active and to interface to that tape management system based on entries in the z/OS subsystem name table.

All features in the currently supported releases of CA 1 Copycat and CA TLMS Copycat (r11) are supported in CA Copycat Utility r12 without modification. Releases prior to r11 used JCL-based allocation of tape devices for input and output; this technique was replaced with the use of dynamic allocation in r11. Users who have not upgraded to CA 1 Copycat r11 or CA TLMS Copycat r11 must install CA Copycat Utility r12 and use the new JCL samples provided in CTAPJCL. Members CTCFLCPY, CTCTPCPY, and CTCTPMAP are provided for FILECOPY, TAPECOPY, and TAPEMAP functions, respectively, in CTAPJCL.

Documentation

This section contains topics related to documentation enhancements.

Installation Guide

The *Installation Guide* has been restructured and describes the following methods of installing CA Copycat Utility:

- CA MSM—CA MSM simplifies and unifies the management of CA mainframe products on z/OS systems. The services provided by CA MSM acquire, install, deploy, and maintain products in a common way.
- Pax-Enhanced Electronic Software Delivery (ESD)—This utility enables you to download and install CA's mainframe software and maintenance electronically to your own disk.
- Tape—You can use the sample JCL to install CA Copycat Utility from tape using the SMP/E RECEIVE-ACCEPT-APPLY method.

CA HTML Bookshelf

This release contains the CA HTML Bookshelf, which is an HTML help system that provides access to all deliverables in the product documentation set in both HTML and PDF. HTML provides robust online viewing and search capabilities, while PDF provides a print-friendly option.

The HTML bookshelf features include:

- A single help screen that displays all documentation for this release.
- An all-in-one search tool that searches the entire documentation set and returns matches found in both the HTML and PDF formatted documentation, without the need for a specialized .PDX index file.
- Additional links for using the Bookshelf, downloading Acrobat Reader, and contacting CA.

Search the Bookshelf

The bookshelf includes a search facility that helps you locate information throughout the set.

Note: If you are unable to use the search capability after following this procedure, download the latest version of Adobe Acrobat Reader for your operating system.

To search the bookshelf

1. Enter your search criteria in the Search field in the upper right corner of the bookshelf and press Enter.

The search returns HTML results listed by topic and PDF results listed by guide. The results are sorted by date so that the most recently updated topics or PDFs appear at the top of the list. To find a topic in a PDF, open the PDF and view the list of topics within the PDF that match the search criteria.

2. (Optional) Click Sort by Relevance.

The list is reordered so that the HTML topics or PDFs that contain the most matches appear at the top of the list.

Note: You can open an individual PDF and use the Adobe Acrobat Search feature to search within the PDF, but searches across the documentation set can be performed only from the bookshelf using the bookshelf's Search field.
