## **CA Mainframe Software Manager**

The following functionality has been added for CA MSM Version 04.0.00:

- Software Deployment Service (SDS)—Use this service to deploy CA Technologies mainframe products to your target enterprise systems.
- Database Migration Tool—Use this tool to migrate your current CA MSM database after you upgrade CA MSM.
- Automatic Download Scheduling—Use this tool to automatically obtain updates for products and product releases on a regular basis.

## **CA MSM Serviceability**

This release of your security product includes enhancements to support CA MSM serviceability, which is part Mainframe 2.0 common services. Serviceability helps users identify, manage, and respond to a failing program.

Serviceability enables the following:

- Ensures that error messages provide clear information for use in problem determination.
- Identifies ownership of resources.
- Ensures module and storage protection.
- Facilitates self-help.
- Simplifies identification of preventative and corrective maintenance.

### **Documentation**

#### **Installation Guide**

The *Installation Guide* has been restructured and describes the following methods of installing CA Librarian:

- CA MSM—CA MSM simplifies and unifies the management of CA mainframe products on z/OS systems. The services provided by CA MSM acquire, install, deploy, and maintain products in a common way.
- Pax-Enhanced Electronic Software Delivery (ESD)—This utility enables you to download and install CA's mainframe software and maintenance electronically to your own disk.
- Tape—You can use the sample JCL to install [set to your product name] from tape using the SMP/E RECEIVE-ACCEPT-APPLY method.

### **Implementation Guide**

#### CA HTML Bookshelf

This release contains the CA HTML bookshelf, which is an HTML help system that provides access to all deliverables in the product documentation set in both HTML and PDF. HTML provides robust online viewing and search capabilities, while PDF provides a print-friendly option.

The HTML bookshelf features include:

- A single help screen that displays all documentation for this release.
- An all-in-one search tool that searches the entire documentation set and returns matches found in both the HTML and PDF formatted documentation, without the need for a specialized .PDX index file.
- Additional links for using the bookshelf, downloading Acrobat Reader, and contacting CA Technologies.

Note: You must have Adobe Reader 8 or above to view the PDF files in the bookshelf.

#### **Access the Bookshelf**

You can access the bookshelf from any page on CA Support Online (CA SO) using the Support By Product or Documentation links in the left navigation column.

To access the bookshelf

- 1. Log into CA Support Online.
- 2. Do one of the following:
  - Click Documentation in the left navigation column. This option lets you view a list of all available bookshelves.
  - Select a bookshelf by product:
    - a. Click Support By Product in the left navigation column.
    - b. Select the product from the drop-down list.
    - c. Click on the Bookshelves option.
- 3. Select the bookshelf you want to open from the list of available bookshelves.

The bookshelf opens in a separate window.

4. Select the guide you want to open from the bookshelf.
