## User-Supplied Exit Name Parameters

Two new parameters, CAKSLOAD\_EXIT and CAKRLOAD\_EXIT, have been added to the CAIKSPAR file to allow you to specify your own exit names for user-written exits. Previously, the exits named CA\$KRLD and CA\$KREX were always loaded and executed by CAKRLOAD and CAKSLOAD, respectively.

- Each of these new parameters, if specified, loads and executes the user-written exit instead of the CA-supplied exit.
- If the new parameters are not specified, the CA-supplied CA\$KRLD and CA\$KREX exits are loaded and executed.

## Configuration with CA MSM

With this release, deployments of CA PMA Chargeback can now be configured with CA MSM.

- X30 -- EXTDATA Record Type S30X
- WTR – EXTDATA Record Type S06
