



Specific Program Documentation

PGP® Encryption Suite, PGP® Gateway Email Encryption, and PGP® Command Line

The Broadcom software program(s) ("Broadcom Software") listed below are provided under the following terms and conditions in addition to any terms and conditions referenced on the Broadcom quote, order form, statement of work, or other mutually agreed ordering document (each a "Transaction Document") under the applicable end user agreement or governing contract (collectively, the "Agreement") entered into by Customer and the Broadcom entity ("Broadcom") through which Customer obtained a license for the Broadcom Software. These terms shall be effective from the effective date of such Transaction Document.

Program Name: PGP® Encryption Suite, PGP® Gateway Email Encryption, and PGP® Command Line

1. DEFINITIONS

- **"Device"** refers to a single computer, storage drive, or other device that (a) can install and use the Broadcom Software, (b) can access and use the Broadcom Software installed on a network, or (c) serves as a physical connection point that links together two separate devices.
- **"Server"** refers to a standalone computer system or virtual machine acting as a service or resource provider to client computers within a network infrastructure. A Server can run server software for other computers or devices.
- **"User"** refers to (a) an individual person and/or Device authorized by Customer to use, and/or benefit from the use of, the Broadcom Software, or (b) the individual person and/or Device who actually uses any portion of the Broadcom Software.

2. USE RIGHTS AND LIMITATIONS

License Models

Customer may use the Broadcom Software to manage the number of Devices, Servers or Users as indicated in the Transaction Document, and in accordance with the following licensing models:

- **Device License.** Customer may use the Broadcom Software for an aggregate number of Devices that does not exceed the quantity of Device licenses specified in the Transaction Document.
- **Server License.** Customer may use the Broadcom Software on an aggregate number of Servers that does not exceed the quantity of Server licenses specified in the Transaction Document.
- **User License.** Customer may use the Broadcom Software for an aggregate number of Users that does not exceed the quantity of User licenses specified in the Transaction Document.

Customer may use the PGP Encryption Suite solely for the number of User licenses as specified in the Transaction Document.

Customer may use Symantec Gateway Email Encryption solely for the number of Server licenses as specified in the Transaction Document.

Additional Restrictions for PGP Command Line

- Customer may use PGP Command Line on the number of Servers as indicated within the Transaction Document solely to automate and/or batch process secure data transmission. If a license authorization from Broadcom is required for any component of PGP Command Line, Customer may only perform and use the components for which Customer has received authorization.
- Customer may internally install and use PGP Command Line on a number of non-production Servers equivalent to the number of licensed servers, solely for redundancy, staging, and/or testing purposes, provided that the copies Customer makes contain all of PGP Command Line's copyright, trademark, and other proprietary rights notices. Such non-production licenses may only be used when the licensed Servers are not being used (i.e., the production and non-production licenses may not be used simultaneously).

3. EVALUATION LICENSE

If PGP Encryption Suite is provided to Customer for evaluation purposes and Customer does not have a separate evaluation agreement, Customer may use such PGP Encryption Suite in accordance with the terms of the Agreement, except:

- (i) Customer's license to PGP Encryption Suite with full functionality shall terminate after a ninety (90) day evaluation period ("Ninety Day Period"), at which time most functionality will be automatically disabled and PGP Encryption Suite will only have limited functionality ("Limited Functionality"); and
- (ii) Upon expiration of the Ninety Day Period, Customer may use PGP Encryption Suite with Limited Functionality pursuant to the license granted and the terms in the Agreement, PGP Encryption Suite may only be used in a non-commercial environment and for a non-commercial purpose.

4. INTERFACES

Development Tool(s) License. If Customer obtains Development Tool(s) with the Broadcom Software, Customer is entitled under this Agreement to use an unlimited number of copies of such Development Tool(s) solely for the purposes of designing, developing, testing, using and demonstrating the integration of the Broadcom Software with Your existing systems, other

Broadcom products, or third party products. The Development Tool(s) license is in addition to any other licenses for the Broadcom Software acquired under this Agreement. Modification or alteration of the Development Tool(s) is prohibited. The Development Tool(s) shall only be used for internal use and may not be distributed or integrated with any other code or product for distribution to third parties.

Open Source Code. Customer's license rights to the Development Tool(s) are conditioned upon compliance with the restriction against creating derivative works that could cause the Development Tool(s) to become Open Source Code. "Open Source Code" refers to software licensed under terms that require disclosure of source materials to parties other than the licensor or that create obligations to distribute any portions of any software used with the Open Source Code.

Third Party Consultants. Customer may allow third party consultants to exercise the rights granted in this section on Customer's behalf provided that: (a) Customer ensures such consultants adhere to the applicable terms and conditions of this Agreement; and (b) Customer indemnifies Broadcom for any breach of this Agreement by such consultants.

Warranty Disclaimer. THE DEVELOPMENT TOOL(S) ARE PROVIDED "AS IS," EXCLUSIVE OF ANY WARRANTY, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, NONINFRINGEMENT, OR ANY OTHER WARRANTY, WHETHER EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED. FURTHERMORE, BROADCOM SHALL NOT BE LIABLE UNDER ANY THEORY FOR ANY DAMAGES SUFFERED BY CUSTOMER OR ANY USER OF THE DEVELOPMENT TOOL(S) OR ANY APPLICATIONS PROVIDED BY CUSTOMER WHICH WERE DEVELOPED USING THE DEVELOPMENT TOOL(S).

The Development Tool(s) enable integration of the Broadcom Software with existing systems, other Broadcom products, or third-party products, subject to the limitations of this section. Broadcom is not responsible for any integration, development, or programming activities undertaken by Customer. Improper use of the Development Tool(s) may cause errors or operational issues with the Broadcom Software. Use of the Development Tool(s) for purposes other than those intended is done at Customer's sole risk, and Broadcom assumes no liability for such use or for any failure of the Development Tool(s) or Broadcom Software due to improper development, programming, installation, configuration, or monitoring.
