1. USE RIGHTS AND LIMITATIONS.

- a. The Customer may use SSLV Visibility for up to the number of Cores as listed on the Transaction Document.
 - i. Cores refer to the processing unit within an appliance CPU, and to meet documented performance requirements.
- b. SSL Visibility (SSLV) is a virtual (software) appliance and is sold as a software subscription. It is then deployed on the Integrated Security Gateway (ISG) as an application. ISG is then deployed with the SSLV virtual appliance on all models of SSP appliances. SSLV is no longer sold with a perpetual software license. Host Categorization is included with the SSLV software subscription. It is no longer sold as an optional add-on.
- c. All deployments of SSLV on hardware appliance models of SSP-S410 require a QAT (Quick Assist Technology) ISG-FRU-QAT-S410, add-on accessory card that increases connections per second performance requirements. The QAT add-on card is not required for any other SSP appliance models, as the CPU on other models includes QAT in the CPU.
- d. At this time, SSLV is not available to run as a standalone virtual appliance on a customer-provided hypervisor virtual infrastructure.
