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Changes to CA-VM:Manager

CA-VM:Manager Service Pack 01 includes maintenance for all component products of CA-VM:Manager, as well as the following:

- Changes to add brand names, and replace company name throughout each component product
- Support for Computer Associates License Management Program (CA LMP) keys as the method of product licensing
- New release of Unicenter VM:Account
- Addition of Unicenter CA-Explore Performance Management for VM to the CA-VM:Manager family of products
- Changes to the VERSION command
- Documentation updates

Name Change

In all CA-VM:Manager component products, references to the product name now contain the Computer Associates brand name (for example, Unicenter or BrightStor). This change is reflected in product initialization messages and the copyright screen.

LMP Key Support

CA LMP keys have been implemented, and the former Sterling CPUID support has been removed.

- The keys are now contained in the CALMP KEYS file instead of VMSI CPUIDS file. The CALMP KEYS file resides on the VMRMAINT 192 disk.
- The product CONFIG file does not support CA LMP keys in the file. Any existing CPUID records will be ignored.
- If you do not have a valid CA LMP key, the product will not be terminated nor will its operation affected in any way. The product will issue warning messages to the operator and to any user entering a product command.

Unicenter VM:Account 1.6

This release of Unicenter VM:Account includes support for the Network Data Transmissions account record type '0C' available in z/VM 4.3. This account record enables you to charge for guest virtual I/O usage for devices:

- Virtual Network Interface Cards (vNIC)
- Virtual channel-to-channel adapters (CTCA)
- IUCV and APPC/VM connection paths

Unicenter CA-Explore 4.3

Unicenter CA-Explore is now part of the CA-VM:Manager family of products. The following enhancements have been added to Unicenter CA-Explore for Release 4.3:

- The LOOKOUT Facility
- LMP Support (SP01)
- z/VM 4.3 Monitor Record Support (SP01)
- CA-VM:Manager Support (SP01)

The VERSION command in each CA-VM:Manager component product has been changed to include information about the release, Genlevel, and Service Pack.

For example, issuing the VERSION command from BrightStor VM:Backup returns this response:

```
