## Chapter 2: Fixed Issues

The chapter details the issues that have been fixed in CA WA Agent for Micro Focus r11.3.2.

#### Cannot Run Micro Focus Jobs as a Domain User

You can run a Micro Focus job with a Micro Focus user ID, an operating system user ID, or both. This release resolves an issue so that you can now run Micro Focus jobs as a domain user, for example, dom01\mfuser01.

#### JCL Error When Resubmitting a a Job from a Particular Job Step

When resubmitting a job from a particular job step, a JCL error occurs when the JCL JOB line exceeds 70 characters. In this release, the agent prevents the issue by reporting a submission error (SUBERROR) when the JCL JOB line exceeds 70 characters.
